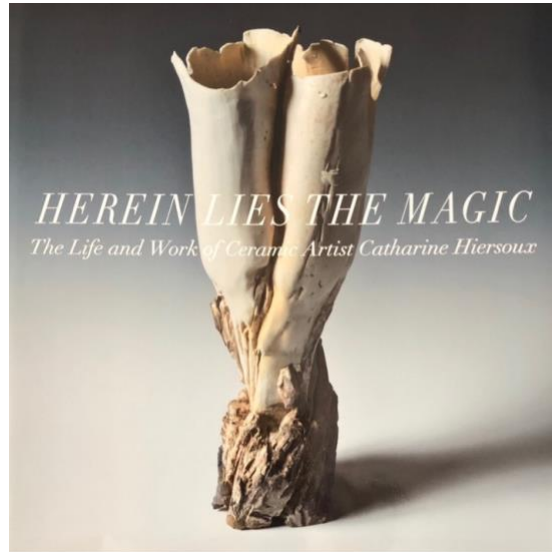

***HEREIN LIES THE MAGIC:
THE LIFE AND WORK OF CERAMIC ARTIST CATHARINE HIERSOUX***



Bay area artist Catharine Hiersoux has worked exclusively in porcelain, continuing a life-long investigation into pushing the limits with the clay to produce the *perfect* pot. This retrospective book charts a path through Catharine’s various phases over 60 years: capturing her classical, spiritual and soulful explorations in ceramics. She says “it is about transformation, about breaking through barriers, feeling the exuberance through the struggle.”

Catharine was commissioned by the White House in 1977. Her work is represented in the permanent collection of the Renwick Gallery of the Smithsonian Institute in Washington DC; the American Craft Museum, NY; the Craft and Folk-Art Museum, Los Angeles; the City of Osaka Collection in Japan; and City of Hong Kong Collection.
